

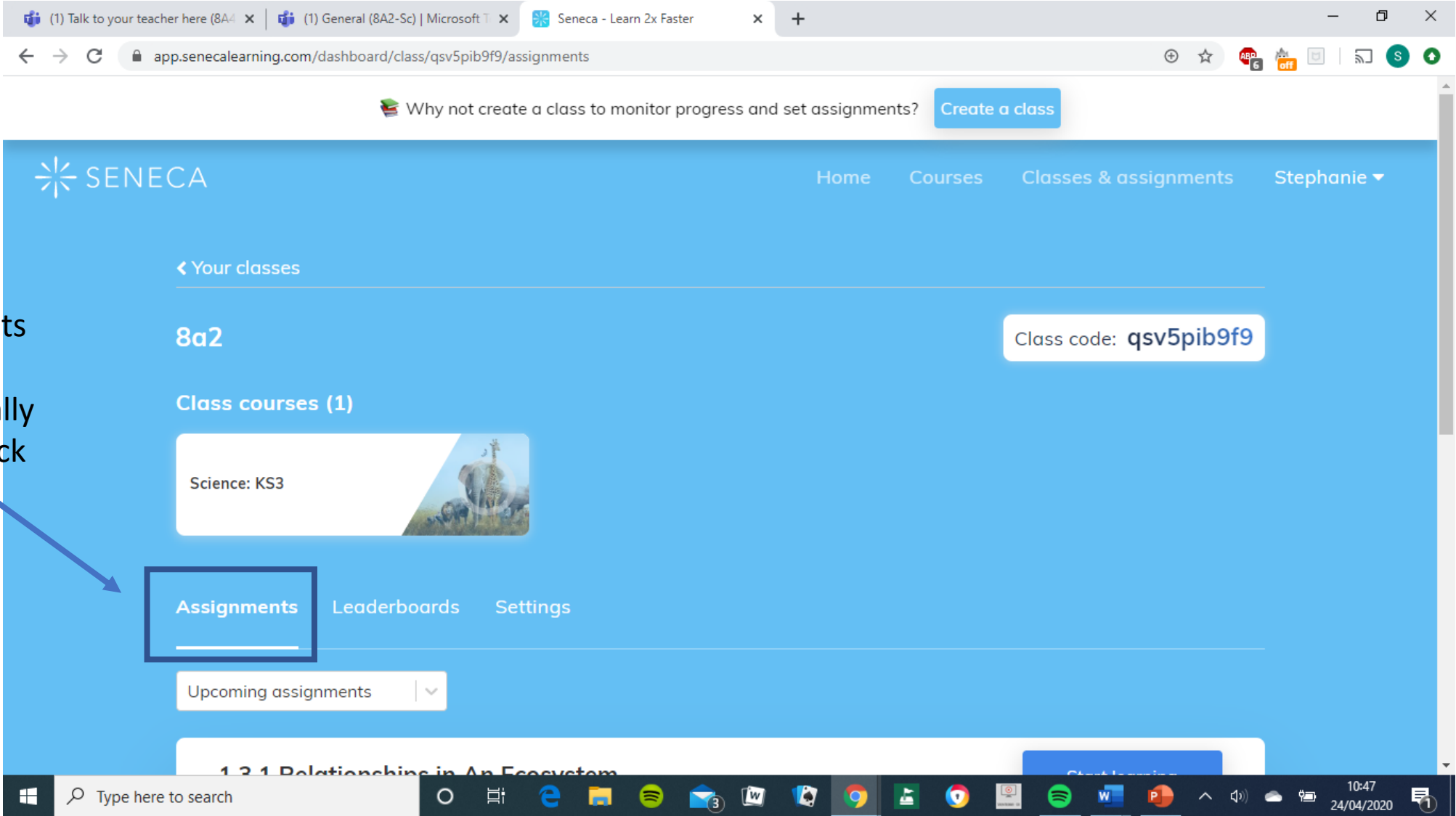
If you can see your class listed click it, if not click Join Class
